He played for Huddersfield Town between 1910 and 1922, wining the FA. Cup once. Mutch joined Newcastle in 1922 and after retiring as a player went on to coach the first-team. He was also employed as a physiotherapist at the club, after studying medicine at school. He left Newcastle in 1986 due to poor health. He died of old age and poor health in 1987
