MEMORANDUM concerning successors to the Estate of the late Miss Minnie Mutch, late of Merkland Road East, Aberdeen, who died at Aberdeen on 24th October, 1971 aged 85, domiciled in the County of Aberdeen, Scotland.

1. Miss Minnie Mutch left no issue and was never married.
2. Miss Mutch never had any brothers or sisters of the full-blood.
3. Miss Mutch had three brothers of the half-blood, namely John Forsyth Mutch born 8th June, 1872, died 15th February, 1902, unmarried; Patrick Ritchie Mutch born 26th July, 1873, died in childhood on 10th December, 1877; and James Alexander Mutch, born February, 1875, died in infancy in May, 1875. These were children of James Mutch, the father of Miss Mutch, by his first marriage which was to Mary Ann McPherson and took place on 21st July, 1871, in Aberdeen.
4. Miss Mutch was predeceased by her father the said James Mutch who died on 4th November, 1896 and by her mother, Barbara Brown (who married the said James Mutch as his second wife on 10th March, 1885, in the U. S. A.) and who died on the 17th March, 1929. Miss Mutch's remoter ancestors also all predeceased her.
5. The parents of James Mutch, father of the late Miss Mutch were Peter Mutch and Isobel or Isabella Ritchie. They were married at Udny, Aberdeenshire, on 30th May, 1835. They had children, legitimised by subsequent marriage or born in wedlock, in addition to James Mutch, the father of the late Miss Mutch as follows:-
 - A. Alexander Mutch, born 30th December, 1834, died 29th April, 1894.

 - H. George Mutch, born 23rd June, 1894 and died 4th June, 1930.
 - I. Forbes Robertson Mutch, born 25th August, 1885 and died 21st February, 1919.

6. Barbara Brown, second wife of James Mitch and the mother of the late Miss Mitch, had a brother and sisters of the full-blood as follows:-

 - C. Mary Jane Brown, date of birth unknown, died 1905-1910.

All of these predeceased the late Miss Mitch.

7. Some children of the first generation born to those persons named under (A) to (I) in paragraphs 5 and in (A) to (D) in paragraph 6 above survived the late Miss Mitch so that Miss Mitch's Estate is divided first of all into as many shares as there are in the aggregate of (1) children of that generation who survived Miss Mitch and (2) children of the first generation who did not so survive, but who had descendants of any generation who survived Miss Mitch. The following paragraphs record the nearest surviving relatives in each branch so far as discovered. They also report instances where in a branch of a family no one has survived to succeed to a share; the benefit in such a case is shared amongst the survivors in that branch. The pattern is illustrated by the following diagram. The fraction of the estate passing to each beneficiary is shown in the left hand margin of the memorandum at paragraph 8-20.
