1845 - September 19th - Alexander Stephen in Auchlerchies by his wife Jane Mutch had a daughter botn and baptized 3rd October and named Christian in presence of the congregation. (Registered with other births)

Marriage: Cruden parish

1848 0 November 25th - Alexander Stephen in the Parish of Udney and Jean Mutch in this Parish contracted marriage and being duly proclaimed were married.

Baptisms: Cruden parish

1848 - December 5th - Said Alexander Stephen by his said wife had a daughter born and baptized 19th Dec and named Janet in presence of the congregation.

1851 - February 16th - Said Alexander Stephen by his said wife had a son born and baptized 3rd March and named Alexander in presence of the congregation.

1853 - June 19th - Said Alexander Stephen by his said wife had a daughter born and baptized 5th July and named Mary in presence of the congregation.

Death: Cruden parish

1857 - April 1st - Alexander Stephen, Ag. Lab., (married), died at Little Mains, Cruden, aged 33, of a disease of the spine (duration - 5 years) and disease of the brain (duration - 19 days). Parents - James Stephen, Farmer and Jessie Stephen m.s. Reith. Buried in Cruden Churchyard. Witness - William Stephen, Brother.
